



Assembly: Steps 1-2


- 1. Put the tub basin (C) on the base (P), bolt the hex bolts (G) washer (H), spring washer (I) and nut (J) to every pre-drilled hole in the tub base (P), as per the attached illustration.
- 2. Put the sponge gasket (L) into the drain (K), and then put them into the hole of the tub basin (C) put the rubber gasket (L) into the drain (K) and use the plastic fix nut (M) to bolt the rubber gasket (L). Connect the hose for the drainage (N) to the drain (K).

Assembly continued: Steps 3-5

3. Attach the Backsplash (A) to the back of the Tub Basin (C) opposite the Door (D) using a Hex Bolt (G), two Washers (H), a Spring Washer (I), and a Nut (J) in every pre-drilled hole, as pictured in the illustration to the right.

4. Bolt the bottom of each Sidesplash (B) to the Tub Basin (C). Use a Hex Bolt (G), two Washers (H), a Spring Washer (I), and a nut (J) in every pre-driled hole.


5. Bolt the side of each Sidesplash (B) to the Backsplash (A) with remaining Hex Bolts, Washers, Spring Washers, and Nuts in every hole.



Assembly continued: Steps 6–10

- 6. Place the Tub Racks (F) into the Tub Basin (C).
- 7. To raise the Tub Racks (F) to a higher level, rest one or both Tub Racks on the Tub Rack Ledge (O) in the center of the Tub Basin (C).
- 8. Adjust the leveling feet on the tub stand to have the drain approximately $\frac{1}{8}$ " lower than the opposite side of the Tub. This allows water to drain better.
- 9. Adjust the Retractable Ramp (E) to desired position.
- 10. Slide Door (D) up and down to open and close.
